

- from Old US Hwy 51 in downtown Cobden, turn eastward onto East Ash Street.
- Follow East Ash Street all the way out to the stop sign at New US Hwy 51.
- Go straight across New US Hwy 51 onto Wing Hill Road and go east.
- a few miles later on Wing Hill Road, you'll take an obvious, rightward curve.
- just past the rightward curve, turn left and cross a wooden bridge. This will still be Wing Hill Road, despite any confusion with the sign there.
- continue on Wing Hill Road for a couple more miles to a fork.
- take the right fork, which is Hall Church Road.
- about a mile further on Hall Church Road, you'll come to a sharp rightward curve. Go STRAIGHT there and stay on Hall Church Road for another 1/4 to 1/2 mile, where Hall Church Road ends at Lick Creek Road, a paved highway.
- turn left onto Lick Creek Road and go east about 1/2 mile to I-57.
- cross over I-57 (MARK YOUR ODOMETER HERE) and continue on Lick Creek Road through the village of Lick Creek.
- at the other side of Lick Creek village, do NOT turn right or left onto South or North Lick Creek Roads.
- continue straight ahead, around a blind corner on Lick Creek Road.
- At about the 2.5-mile mark on your odometer, you will have just traveled through 2 prominent S-curves. You'll be in front of the south face of Draper Bluff on your left.
- Pass by 2 driveways on your left, the second of which has a big gate.
- Look for the large "Vertical Heartland" sign on the left.
- We rendezvous in this parking lot.
